Applications are invited for the position of Director of the Illinois Sustainable Technology Center (ISTC), a department of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign within the Institute of Natural Resource Sustainability (INRS). With its national reputation, ISTC promotes sustainability by providing technical assistance, conducting & sponsoring research, and disseminating information on environmental issues. The Director provides scientific leadership and administrative direction for the development, coordination, and implementation of programs, activities and professional services undertaken by a staff of approximately 40, primarily engineers and chemists. She/he reports directly to the Executive Director of the INRS and interacts regularly with all levels of government, industry, and the public to maintain and enhance the Center's reputation for excellence and objectivity in science and public service.

Qualifications: the candidate must possess a doctorate-level degree in an engineering or scientific discipline or a juris-doctorate (JD). At least five years experience with the following is required: 1) managing a large and/or complex organization operating in a technical environment; and 2) working in an industrial pollution prevention and/or waste management or related area. Candidates must possess a demonstrated substantive and sustained record of accomplishment of publishing and obtaining external sponsored funding. Salary range: \$148,000 to \$153,000 commensurate with qualifications and experience. Proof of U.S. citizenship or current eligibility for U.S. employment will be required prior to applying.
