The Thomas Jefferson Planning District Commission is a Virginia regional planning agency serving five counties and the City of Charlottesville in central Virginia (see tjpd.org for further information). The Senior Environmental Planner will take the lead for the agency's environmental program. Subject areas for the environmental program include water quality, stormwater, energy, habitat, open space/conservation, solid waste, and possibly brownfields. The Senior Environmental Planner will be expected to work with agency management to broaden the scope and increase the sophistication of the environmental program. In that role the Senior Environmental Planner will be responsible for a variety of tasks including but not limited to development of environmental plans and studies, project management, and grant writing. The Senior Environmental Planner will represent TJPDC with other environmental agencies, provide environmental planning services to TJPDC member governments and work with TJPDC staff for community development and transportation to incorporate environmental issues into those programs. Knowledge, skills and experience in key environmental subject areas identified above, project management, and grant writing are required. Excellent written and oral communications skills are necessary. Preference will be given to candidates possessing hands on experience with GIS and ESRI software. A bachelor's degree in environmental planning or a related field and four to seven years of experience is required. A master's degree in an environmental planning related field is preferred.
